8IATC 2018 Conference Abstract Guidelines:

Abstracts must be submitted online as Microsoft Word documents only using a specific format - an abstract template is available online and must be used for all abstracts submitted.

- Abstracts must be a minimum of 250 words, and no longer than 300 words
- Abstracts must be submitted in Arial 11 point font
- The abstract title must be typed in Arial 14 point, bold and centred font
- The presenting author/s name/s must be typed in bold
- All author details and affiliations must be included
- The first author's email address must be included
- Authors must include a maximum of five keywords sufficient to highlight the relevant topics addressed in your paper.
- Abstracts must be text only - graphics, pictures or graphs should not be included.
- The addition of 3 - 5 references used in the preparation of the presentation.

Please note that while there is no limit on the number of abstracts you can submit, the Conference Program Committee will, where possible, limit the number of presentations per first author to one.

Presenters of accepted abstracts are required to register and pay to attend the Conference as a delegate for at least the day they are presenting.

Submission of abstracts implies the author's agreement to prepare and publish their extended abstract in the final Conference Program Handbook and on the Conference website once the event has concluded.

Successful papers must be presented by the lead author/s or a nominated co-author. The presenting author's name must be listed in bold font in the author list.

Acceptance of abstracts does not imply any payment from the Conference Committee. Authors must arrange and pay their own accommodation, travel etc. to attend the Conference.

Acceptance or otherwise is at the discretion of the Conference Program Committee whose decision is final.
